November kicks off our Master Artist Workshop series, with outstanding artists holding workshops in the Lightner Master Artist Studio at the Center for Performing Arts. This season's Off the Walls will take place on Friday January, 19 and it's not too early to get your ticket to that fun fundraiser. You could also get tickets to use as stocking stuffers for your fellow art lovers. Or, if you find you are busy running around and need something constructive, creative and fun for your kids to do during the holidays, Holiday Fun Camps are available during the weeks of Christmas and New Year's.

I know many of you also are looking forward to this year's Members Exhibition, which takes place in February. The ensemble will feature six classically trained musicians, including Southwest Florida Symphony Orchestra principal viola player and FSW State College professor of violin and viola, Rachel Cox.
